Great Book Discussion Questions – *Desire Under the Elms*

- 1. Does the dialogue get in the way of understanding the story? Why or why not?
- 2. What is the "something" that permeates the Cabot household? Is it the spirit of Eben's mother? Is it evil? Is it lust (for land or women, or gold)?
- 3. Do you think the characters of Peter and Simeon are fully developed, or are they 2 dimensional?
- 4. What is the nature of Cabot's hardness? Is it hardness of spirit, or hardness of heart?
- 5. Is Abbie a likeable figure? Does she intend to "swallow everything up," as Eben thinks when he first meets her?
- 6. Is Cabot mad for believing that Abbie and he have conceived a son? Is this just another side of his vanity? Does he understand the taunts of his neighbors regarding the baby, or is he blocking the taunts out of his mind?
- 7. Does Cabot see himself as a Biblical figure, and if so, why?
- 8. Does it seem believable that Eben would turn Abbie in as a murderer? Why or why not?
